#### Prayer Still Works!!!

A Real Life prayer story

One morning in 2015 a desperate plea for God's intervention appeared in Son Broadcasting's Prayer email. "My 37 year old son is dealing with feelings of guilt, failure and abandonment. He internalizes his problems and stress and has turned to alcohol and marijuana to escape. Please pray for him to fight the lies of satan and the trap of oppression. He needs to be set free and to live his life as a God-fearing, healthy young man who emulates Jesus to his family. Son Broadcasting's Prayer Partners responded by interceding and with a written prayer by return email. A few months later this mother wrote back, "Just a note to thank you for your prayers. without further updates on this man's situation until February of this year when this email came from his mother:

"After you responded to my email with a prayer, some time went by. I have to admit, I didn't see many good results. I had no choice but to keep believing and thanking the Lord for deliverance. Things were looking very bleak.

I drove home wondering, crying, praying, and trying not to doubt. One day the Holy Ghost spoke to me and told me exactly what to do. Right away I did just that!! I had no idea of the real seriousness of this issue because my daughter-in-law did not want to worry me, but Jesus knew all about it. My husband says that when I stepped out in obedience to the directions of the Holy Ghost, my faith set the wheels in motion for His plan to work.

That same week, my son was in a car accident that could have killed him. But the Lord intervened and protected. My son came face to face with the reality of the accident, his wife evicting him from their home and a failed drug test that threatened his employment. It all piled up at once and came down hard upon him! My son chose to cry out to Jesus for help and Jesus delivered him from the alcohol and the marijuana.

So, I do have quite a testimony!! JESUS IS a deliverer!!! HE IS A DELIVERER!! I thank you so much for your support, and prayers. Just in case you have any doubt, PRAYER STILL WORKS!!"
