**Let Everything That Has Breath...**

It is recorded in 2 Chronicles 20 that three bands of people - the Ammonites, Moabites and Edomites - came against Jerusalem during the reign of King Jehoshaphat. The king, being fearful, called for a fast throughout the kingdom of Judah. On behalf of all the people, Jehoshaphat appealed to heaven for mercy and deliverance. It was then that a Levite began to prophesy to the king saying, "Listen, Judah, and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you King Jehoshaphat.... Do not be afraid nor dismayed... for the battle is not yours, but God's" (2 Chronicles 20:15). He continued to prophesy, instructing them to go to battle being assured that the LORD was with them.


The next morning as the king prepared to lead his army against the invaders, instead of putting the most experienced warriors at the head of the column, he "appointed singers unto the LORD that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army" (2 Chronicles 20:21). As His people began to sing praises unto Him, the LORD set an ambush against the enemies of Israel and "they were smitten" (2 Chronicles 20:22).

## Let Everything That Has Breath continued....

We all face situations where it seems the odds against us are overwhelming. In those moments it is our nature to become fearful and to doubt that deliverance will come. Scripture, on the other hand, encourages us to do the opposite of what seems logical at that moment. Instead of giving in to the fear, we are encouraged to sing and to praise the Almighty. To do this in fearful situations requires us to override the emotions we are experiencing and to offer a sacrifice of praise.

The Bible tells us that the LORD inhabits - literally, "is enthroned upon" - the praises of His people, Israel (Psalm 22:3). It would seem that our adulation and praise offered unto Him with pure hearts motivates Him to go to war on our behalf. So, when we find ourselves being overwhelmed by the enemy, remember what the Psalmist said: "Let everything that has breath, praise the LORD."

# As in the Days of Noah

by "7th Street Theater" airs on KCHF TV Friday at 2:30am

The episode "Mayday" in the TV series 7TH STREET THEATER is about 3 people stranded on a life raft in the middle of the ocean. One is an atheistic stockbroker, one is a non-believing flight attendant, and the other is a missionary from Ireland. The subject of the second coming of Christ comes up and in particular, this verse: "But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be" (Matt 24:37).

The missionary takes them back in the Bible to the book of Genesis and gives them a picture of how things were during the time of Noah when he built this big boat called an ark. It's also a time when God brought a flood of judgment on the earth that destroyed all of life but 8 people.

The second coming of Jesus will be just like what happened during the days of Noah. As the missionary studied the story in Genesis, he noticed there were six different kinds of people living during the time while Noah constructed the ark. These same six groups exist today toward the person and message of Jesus Christ.

First, while Noah built the ark there were people who didn't even know it. The same is true today. There are people living who have never heard the name of Jesus Christ and know absolutely nothing about Him.

Second, there were people during Noah's time who didn't

think anything about the ark. Today, this group also exists. There are many people who just don't ever think about Jesus or have anything to do with Him.

Third, there were people who mocked Noah. These people are present with us today. There are some who mock the Lord Jesus Christ.

Fourth, there are people who admired the ark Noah was building. They thought it was an impressive structure. These people exist even today. A number of people admire the teachings of Jesus Christ.

Fifth, there was the *religious* group during Noah's day. These people listened to Noah, saw what he was doing, and heard his warning. But, they thought they were okay and didn't need to examine themselves or take any action. Then, suddenly, the floods came, and it was too late. Today, this group also exists. These are people who are church members, or are religious, or are good people, or might even be professing Christians. They say they know Jesus, but don't have a true personal relationship with Him.

Sixth and last, the only group of people who survived the flood in Noah's day were those 8 souls who were in the ark. The same is true today. We must be in Christ to be saved from the wrath of God facing all of mankind in the very near future.



## Josiah Henson: The Real Uncle Tom - Parts 1 & 2 - February 19th at 9pm (1hr)


