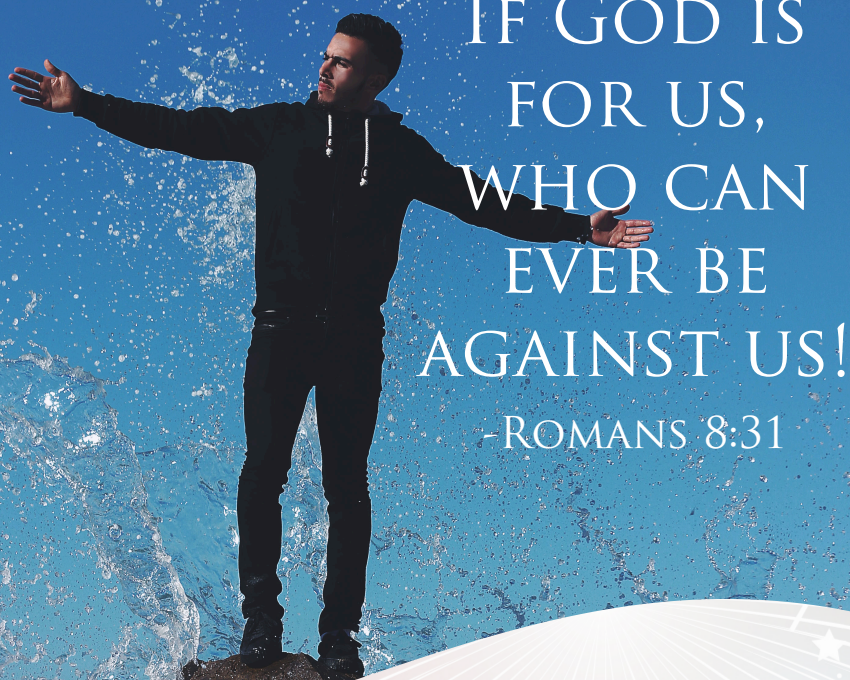

## God's Willingness to Answer Our Prayers

*Prayer is not overcoming God's reluctance. It is laying hold of His willingness. --Martin Luther*

Prayer, a cornerstone of the practice of our Christian faith, is often an under-used or misused element of our relationship with God. Certainly, the joy of answered prayer is exhilarating. But how often have we heard of, or even personally experienced the disappointment or disillusionment of unanswered prayer? When prayer seems to have gone unanswered, or worse yet, unheard, it can cause confusion, sadness, and even contribute to a breakdown of faith.

God *always* hears the prayers of those who fear Him. Psalm 66 says, "If I had cherished iniquity in my heart, the Lord would not have listened. But truly God has listened; He has attended to the voice of my prayer." So, if He hears us, how do we know we will get what we ask for? 1 John 5:14 says, "If we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him."



The key is that we ask "according to His will". We know His will by having a working knowledge of His promises made to us in the Bible, and by having a prayer life that pursues fellowship and dialogue with Him. The Bible is a testament of His will. And in it He promises that, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me." John 10:27

We're confident that we have what we pray when our prayer agrees with His promises to us. Such confidence is not influenced by outward circumstances. It ignores the passage of time. It refuses to doubt because we've learned of His eagerness and willingness to bless us -- according to His promises!

## The Blessings of the Sabbath

The true Biblical Sabbath is the 7<sup>th</sup> day of the week or what the pagan calendar calls "Saturn-day". For those of us who believe that the world was created in six literal days- we also believe that on the 7<sup>th</sup> day Elohim (God) ceased from His work and set apart the day as a holy-day to Himself. He then gave it to Adam (mankind) for refreshment and for Adam to spend a day with Him.

Like most readers, I grew-up with the 1<sup>st</sup> day, "Sun-day," as the Sabbath. Since becoming a believer, the 4<sup>th</sup> Commandment convicted me. I heard, studied and taught the arguments for the switch but that didn't quiet the questions. Then one day I gave in and became a Sabbath-Keeper; my spiritual life changed and my relationship with Him became closer and more profound. I have come to the conclusion that the Sabbath "was made for mankind" as Yeshua taught in Mark 2 and mankind is not taking advantage of this Elohim-given gift.

The Sabbath is called "Kadosh"- a "Holy" day which means a "set-apart" day; its opposite is a common-day, of which there are six. No work is to be done for 24 hours, light or heavy, in our businesses or at home and no spending money on that day. (Lev. 23:3; Is. 56:2, 6; Is 58:13,14)

There are three ways that the Biblical Sabbath can change your life and bring you closer to His Presence:

- This day is called a Mo'ed"- an "Appointed time;" a date, a reservation, an appointment with the Creator. This is the Obedience Factor; blessings come with obedience. Yeshua and Paul kept Elohim's Sabbath; shouldn't we?
- The secondary purpose for Sabbath is for our rest. Our bodies are fragile and rest is a necessary component to health. Adonai wants us healthy for His Kingdom-work.
- The Sabbath is also a day for Sacred-Assembly. (Lev. 23:3) The Hebrew word is "Mikrah" a meeting, a convocation. This is the time to come and study Torah and the rest of the scriptures. A time for gathering with the "Body of Messiah."

It is my prayer that this short digest will encourage you to "...search the Scriptures to see if these things be so" and receive the "Blessings of the Sabbath" in your life and the life of your congregation. Shalom!

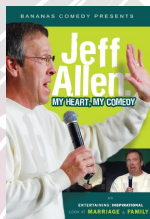

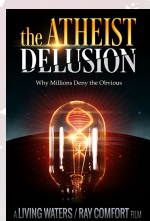

**Jeff Allen: My Heart, My Comedy - July 9th at 8pm (2hrs)**



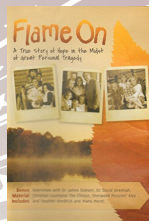
Comedian Jeff Allen provides both laughter and encouragement in this comedy special that includes a heartfelt, eye-opening testimony with Jeff and his wife.

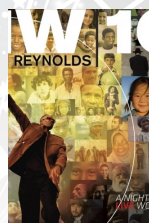
