When God gives us a vision and there is no immediate fulfillment, the temptation is to give up. Don't. Keep hanging on to God's Word!

Shortly after giving my life to the Lord in England in 1976, I first sensed His leading to come to America. In 1977, I was 20, had just graduated high school, was living with my parents and broke.

I began sharing with my parents and friends at church that I was going to emigrate to America. As the weeks and months passed with no manifestation of that declaration, they began looking at me quizzically. I kept the vision in my heart, and in mid 1978, I



finally arrived in Orlando, Florida, with \$50 in my pocket.

Not really sure what I wanted to do other than work for God and share about His love, I plunged right ahead trying to carry out God's directive in my own steam. Unfortunately, this didn't work very well and I became homeless. While being homeless wasn't pleasant, it did provide me invaluable insights in preparation for what was going to become my life's work: sharing God's love in tangible ways with the homeless.

Never Give Up continued...

After quickly making up my mind that I would return to doing things God's way, He began to clarify His vision for my life. From 1982 through 1986 I opened up a coffeehouse/overnight shelter for homeless men in Santa Fe. It was an amazing experience with many ups and downs. Now, I looking back in retrospect, I can see God's hand was at work.

Challenges? In those four years I had two front teeth punched out by a drunk, took only four days off, resigned the ministry, and "told" God I would do anything He wanted except open up another shelter. Never tell God never-it's just not a good idea.

Within a short period of time, I again, had to submit to God's plans, not mine. This is when the property which is now Joy Junction became available. God's vision was a shelter which would keep entire homeless families together at one of the worst times in their lives.

Over the last 31 years, Joy Junction has become New Mexico's largest emergency homeless shelter. God's faithfulness and His people's generosity allow us to shelter as many as 300 people nightly and feed as many as 16,000 people a month--all without government assistance.

The moral? Ask God for a vision and keep it tucked away in your heart, even when nothing seems to be happening. Just remember, God's vision may not unfold according to our timing as He prepares us to bless other people...but keep believing and it WILL happen.



Praise that Precedes Victory

At the seventh time, when the priests blew the trumpets, Joshua said to the people, "Shout! For the Lord has given you the city." Joshua 6:16

When Joshua was commanded by God to lead his army around the city of Jericho in battle formation for seven days without engaging the enemy, he must have wondered what on earth they were doing! March seven times around the outer walls? Shout victoriously before even encountering a single soul? What good could possibly come from such a presumptuous display of confidence? And yet, their shouts dropped the walls! The Israelites gave God the glory and trusted in His provision before they had fired a single arrow, or wielded a single sword. And God ultimately gave them victory.

When we face our own insurmountable walls how should we respond? We can cry out in fear, asking why and how and what

now. Or we can praise God and wait with expectant hope for victory to come. In my own personal times of trial I have sometimes had to praise Him through clenched teeth. With tears in my eyes, I have repeated the words of a well-known Christian song, "Blessed be your name; on the road marked with suffering, though there's pain in the offering, blessed be your name." And I have discovered that when I address Him this way, before I have seen any evidence of deliverance, He works in my circumstances, but mostly in my heart, enabling me to trust Him more.

Praising God while the walls still stand demonstrates our belief that He is worthy, no matter what the outcome. And God loves to respond in the afterglow of our praise. The next time you face a challenge, try praising Him for the unseen victory. Praise Him in the waiting. Praise Him in the suffering. Then wait and see what walls God will drop!


